Following the refugees and migrants from their arrival to the Greek Islands by boat, along the Balkan Route as they make this exhausting journey in the hope of reaching western Europe to begin a new life free from war, death and economic hardship.

The migration crisis is a metaphor for our world and its inequalities. The arrival and the perpetuity of the hundreds of thousands of new migrants in Europe, unmasks the reality that in our society, the right to freedom of movement and the right to a decent life is not the same for everybody, and demonstrates how Western society, through these inequalities, seeks to preserve its privileges.







## Biography Giulio Piscitelli

Giulio Piscitelli (b. 1981, Napoli) approached photography in 2008 and after earning a degree in Communication Studies began his photographic career with Italian and foreign news agencies.

His work has concentrated on international current affairs, Giulio has dedicated a substantial amount of time over the past 5 years to a long term project “From there to here” that focuses on the immigration crisis in Europe. In recent years he has expanded his interest to other international crises such as the coup in Egypt and the wars in both Syria and Ukraine.

Giulio’s photographic dispatches have been published by leading national and international newspapers and magazines. His work has been selected for exhibitions in spaces such as Villa Pignatelli, University of Catanzaro, International Festival of Journalism in Perugia, Angkor Photo Festival, Brera Gallery; Visa Pour L’Image Festival; Hannover photo festival; La Maternità d’Elne; Night of photography in Switzerland; Bangkok photo festival; Annenberg Space for Photography.
